IMPLEMENTATION OF THE FIELD TRIALS IN GREECE

- ECEC staff created a leaflet to inform the parents about positive psychology and how the ProW programme could contribute to improve the ECEC settings.
- ECEC staff developed a common vision and philosophy on dealing with challenging behaviors for each ECEC setting and identified two to three schoolwide expectations (e.g., be tolerant) & behavioral rules



PARTICIPATING ECEC SETTINGS, STAFF AND CHILDREN

 The Greek National ProW leadership team identified 33 Greek ECEC settings

TWO GROUPS:

- Treatment group:
 - 18 ECEC settings
 - 94 ECEC teachers
 - 1082 children

Control group:

- 15 ECEC settings
- 92 ECEC teachers
- 1067 children

EXTERNAL COACHES

- Meetings on regulary basis with other European coaches and coordinators
- Coaches developed, refined and implemented training materials in target ECEC settings following the guidelines of the research partners.
- Frequent visits on the online platform
 (Moodle) to access resources and upload material.

PRESCHOOL TEACHERS TRAINING

From November to
 December, the Greek
 external coaches
 provided five training
 sessions to preschool
 teachers participating in
 the project (control
 group).



- On April 2022, Family interviews were conducted to explore parents' views on how they perceive their children's participation in ECEC settings where ProW is running
- On June 2022 (T2), preschool teachers completed questionnaires about their and students' variables
- Between September-December 2022 (T3), preschool teachers completed questionnaires about their and students' variables
